You are **required** to submit a final history degree plan for review and approval at least two quarters *before* you intend to graduate. Your senior check form must include completed, in progress, and future coursework needed to satisfy your history degree requirements. Your senior check form must be filled out in its entirety. The only permissible blank spaces are fields for grades you have yet to receive. You must indicate both the name and number for each course, e.g., 10A, *United States History to 1877*. **Incomplete forms will not be accepted for review.**

Submit your completed senior check form to the History Department office: Humanities 1, room 201. You will be notified by an email sent to your UCSC address once your senior check form has been reviewed.

- No more than four lower-division courses (HIS 1 – 99) may be applied to the history major requirements.
- Courses graded C-, D, F, or No Pass cannot be used to satisfy major requirements.
